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**Minutes Of The
Special Meeting of Representatives from the
Board of Trustees and Staff of the Village of Oak Brook
and the Board of Park Commissioners and Staff
of the Oak Brook Park District
Wednesday, September 25, 2013, 8:30 p.m.**

The meeting commenced at the Oak Brook Park District Family Recreation Center parking lot sign, located at the 4 way stop-sign on Forest Gate Road and proceeded to various field locations.

1. Call to Order

Bill Hudson, Building Inspections Supervisor of the Village of Oak Brook, opened the Special Meeting at 8:28pm. Hudson stated this meeting was for data collection and that Rick Kellen, P.E., LC, of Line Associates, would be taking readings from several areas around Forest Gate. Residents should contact the village if they have a request for an area to be evaluated. Hudson stated that no results of the light readings would be available tonight.

2. Roll Call

a. Board of Trustees and Staff of the Village of Oak Brook

In attendance from the Village of Oak Brook: Village President Dr. Gopal Lamalani and Village Trustees Michael Manzo, Jerry Wolin, Dr. Mark Moy, John Baar, and Don Adler. Also in attendance were Bill Hudson, Building Inspections Supervisor; Charlotte Pruss, Village Clerk; and the lighting consultant, Richard Kellen of Line Associates.

b. Board of Park Commissioners and Staff of the Oak Brook Park District

In attendance from the Oak Brook Park District: President of the Board of Park Commissioners, John O'Brien, and Commissioners Frank Trombetta and Kathy Carson. Also in attendance were Laure Kosey, Executive Director; Clint Lauderdale, Director of Parks and Facilities; Dave Thommes, Director of Recreation; Chris Piasecki, Athletic and Recreation Manager; and Mary Tansey, Corporate Relations.

c. Attendance of Oak Brook Residents

3. Discussion with Rick Kellen, P.E., LC, of Line Associates for analysis of field lights.

The first light reading was conducted on the west side of the Forest Gate Subdivision at Lot 68. Andrea Cygan stated that at this time, the impact of lights is dramatically different with the deciduous trees being in leaf growth. Bill Hudson stated there would be another date to view the lights after leaf fall, but the date is yet to be determined. Hudson stated that residents' concerns have directed where the lighting consultant performs the light readings. However, at the meeting, the lighting consultant would not be able address findings at this time. Ernie Kallas stated that he would like the consultant to perform the light readings as if the consultant was on the second floor of a house in the subdivision so a more accurate testing of the lights could be conducted. However, there currently is no house on Lot 68.


The second reading was conducted at the entrance of Forest Gate Subdivision near the gate house. Richard Kellen, lighting consultant, stated the preliminary work conducted tonight had been identified by Bob Kallien, Community Development Director, and was to concentrate on the soccer field light readings.

Bill Hudson directed the meeting attendees to walk to the east side of the Forest Gate Subdivision for the third light reading, which was conducted at Lot 69, due to the residents' concerns about the soccer field lights. Marcos Lopez requested for the consultant to take a reading from the garage light on the house next to Lot 69 for a comparison in light readings between the garage light and the light from the soccer field.

The fourth light reading was held in the middle of the Forest Gate Road near the gate house of the Forest Gate Subdivision. Laure Kosey stated that the soccer field with lights is currently being rented during the special meeting. Robert Bievers, an Oak Brook Resident, drove by the test site and stated he was in favor of the extension of lights with reflectors so they don't have glare. Ernie Kallas stated they have more locations for the consultant to do readings but will provide the locations at the next reading because they are all on the other side of the subdivision.

4. Adjournment

Village Trustee John Baar made a motion, seconded by Village Trustee Michael Manzo, to adjourn the special meeting at 9:33pm.
